

## **What's happening with the World Digital Mathematics Library?**

The idea of a World Digital Mathematics Library, collecting together the mathematics literature in a free, accessible, and searchable form, first arose in the late 1990's. An initial period of great enthusiasm was followed by gradually diminishing activity. But, recently, a new initiative has arisen, spearheaded by the Sloan Foundation, the IMU, and the National Academy. In this talk, I will discuss what is going on, the issues being raised, and how it might relate to reproducibility.
